



My journey into adolescent health began much before IAP in 2000 when we declared IAP year of adol health under my presidentship

In 1986 Delhi PEDICON I presented my first paper on **PARENTING OF ADOLESCENTS**37 years ago

Since 2015 Family Guidance Parents, Grandparents AYAs Extended adol 25-0 yrs

Classical counselling – is not telling the client what to do ..but helping him to reach his own plan of action – facilitation

Takes minimum 45 min 1 hour /session

Many sessions required – used to do before ...

Now I f I feel a client requires such prolonged counselling and or sessions of CBT and REBT –

normally refer to the clinical psychologists and counsellors in my team

At my level of energy and limited time ...

I do more of Prescriptive counselling in addition to Preventive counselling & anticipatory guidance – for parents

We have to modify our parenting and as experts The parental guidance we give AS PER THE CHANGING TIMES



Parenting in the new social order

- Due to rapid evolution of technologies social orders also changes rapidly
- A "New Social Order" implies a significant and transformative change in the way society is organized, its values, norms, institutions, or power structures.


Many many issues for guiding parents of children and Adolescents



BASIC CHANGES IN YOUTH

- Loss of childhood innocence.
- Premature exposure to sex related issues and lack of emotional maturity to handle these issues. (UK study tablet use 2-5 Yrs age)
- Physically capable doing and enjoying sexual intimacy but ...NOT YET CAPABLE of handling the emotional consequences or medical issues that result from it .
- Extreme peer pressure to "fit in", "be cool and hep"

Media effect Premature wanting to grow up!!



Basic challenges for parents

- Difficult- breaking away from age old rigid society norms and Indian traditions.
- Tough to deal with the recent changes

- Confusion / Difficulty in acceptance of new terms
- Change in past definitions
 - Immoral NOW personal choice or lifestyle
 - Perversion..... NOW different orientation

Basic issues for parents

- Not easy to become tolerant / accept
- balance between rigidity –strictness permissiveness or tolerance
- issues of sexual precociousness.
- How to accept what we feel as "promiscuousness"
- Accepting and helping to dealing with unwanted teen pregnancy, sexually transmitted infections.
- Shattered emotions of a dumped or rejected AYAs

UNREALISTIC EXPECTATIONS FROM PARENTS

Issues with education

- Craze to go aboard from school itself
- Many children do not want to go through boards, competitive exams
- Feel education abroad is free of corruption, nepotism etc etc
- Many parents cannot afford
- Many parents worried about sending adol alone at such a young age
- Tremendous conflicts refusal to study Indian course

Issues with education

How do I handle these issues?

- Lot of sessions with the adolescents –
- To give them a reality check of what education aboard means..
- Making them appreciate the parental financial situations
- In affluent families sharing with them real life experiences of going abroad at a young age – inability to handle the pressures
 - Sexual experimentations, free beer nights, racism, violence, loneliness, depression, coming back leaving course midway etc etc
 - Persuading them to finish UG in India and then going abroad for PG

Issues with education

Not wanting to complete boards

Some children 8th and 9th who win prizes in some talent shows – video making ,singing , aps coding etc

- Get very grandiose ideas of their becoming self sufficient entrepreneurs
- Want parents to support their talent and invest money in their ventures
- Do not want to go through boards
- They Give eg of Bill Gates and others who have excelled in life without formal education
 - REALITY CHECK one needs a formal education- training and degree in the adult.
 - Importance of standing on their feet and not being dependant on parents – al life

Issues with education Many of these have are been doctors children brought to me for urgent counseling for not wanting to appearing for Competitive exams

 1) sudden decision not wanting to appear for the competitive exams- generally a panic reaction or lack of confidence – fear of failure and facing parental and societal disappointment

2) decision to drop from professional courses Midway

I have got 99% success rate of motivating these children

- 1) to appear for the exam
- 2) Complete the course and them choose another carer path
- 3) In a few cases counsel the parents to accept the situation and find a new path if youngsters are very distressed or very sure

Issues of Youngsters who have gone abroad for PG

- Getting good opportunity abroad and wanting to now settle there
- Some still expecting financial support
- Finding a live in relationship
 - Partner from different country, race, religion
 - Not wanting marriage /children
 - The partner- different sexual orientation

After coming back difficulty in adjusting to India

I do a lot of free sessions for parents and Young adults of Low SE groups

In situations where parents from very Low SE status have supported children to achieve high educations status

- Over my relocations I have helped most of my domestic helps- maids, cooks, drivers etc for their children - with financial help, career guidance counseling....
- It is very heartening to see their children becomes CA,
 MBA, doctors, engineers, scientist PhD
- Some are very grateful to their parents and not ashamed of their roots
- Some want to completely dissociate from the parents and families and form a life of their own
- Difficulty in getting marriage partners specially for a highly educated girl in their community



How to handle?

- It is heart rendering when these domestic help come and share what their highly educated children are putting them through after all the sacrifices done
- Lot of sessions with youngsters
- To give them a reality check of what parents have done for them and the courage to overcome the false sense of prestige and be Proud and accepting of their roots
- Support parents through the agony of going through the situation



2014 - AACCI invited by JJ committee Pilot Project for Reduction of Anger, violence in children in Observation Homes


This was after the breakout of children in some Delhi remand homes with violence and arson

We took Co –Partner in Delhi Urvi Vikram Charitable Trust- – UVCT Dr. UNB Rao

We did survey in Feb 2014 as a voluntary research and suggested interventions
They put us on a paid contract to implement- which we did for a month
We were offered a 2 yr contract to work ..But we were going to relocate from leave Delhi
in 2014 end and hence could not take up this mission



We conducted a lot of LSE sessions for them



Drawing 1 this boy understands that tobacco and alcohol destroys life. He can motivated for de-addiction and results are more likely to be positive

Art therapy -Substance abuse

Making drawings during various LSE Sessions gives an insight into the mind And helps plan therapy and what Approach to take in counseling

Drawing 2 This boy says that once a person is under the influence of alcohol he is not responsible for this actions and has used a popular Hindi film dialogue to support this

Intensive counseling will be required for this boy as he will have no remorse or guilt about his action when done under influence of Alcohol as happens in most gang rape cases

What counseling can you do for parents in situation ???
Any guidance you give is futile – unless the whole social fabric and
The socioeconomic milieu changes

Many of this kids had mental health issues – treatable causes like ADHD, learning disorders

And almost all were substance abuse addicts



Modern times in India

Last 20 years I have been doing counselling and family guidance for elite and upper socioeconomic groups in various metro cities. This includes premarital and immediate post martial counselling

- Over years, interacting with many generation of adolescent girls, young women and their mothers, I can see the changing mind set of both the young girls and parents
- We as adolescent stake holders will have to deal with this changed scenario and respect their views though they may be contrary to our values ingrained as an older generation
- Modern times have ushered in new imperatives in our thought processes, value judgements and psyche.
- It is nowhere as poignantly manifest as our approaches to marriage, motherhood, and pre-marital intimate relationships.
- Todays young girls are emancipated, highly educated and financially independent
- Todays Boys have a very different mind set than men of the older generation






We were taught that when you get an adolescent who has indulged in premarital sex and has come with consequences of unwanted pregnancy or STD's, whatever are your moral values, your job is to help and guide the adolescent.

I am getting increasingly high numbers of youngsters brought to me for counselling by frustrated parents

(and parental counselling for themselves as they are distressed)

- Many youngsters today specially- girls do not believe in getting married and /or having children
- Many don't believe in monogamous relationships
- Some have a series of live in relationships
- some are also in a different sexual orientation relationship.

- As an oldy I strongly believe in the institution of marriage and monogamy, fidelity and also the joy of motherhood and importance of procreation for preserving the human race.
- But we have to understand and accept the mindset of these youngsters and also guide parents how to accept and deal with these situations



Issues of Conflict with Parents and Youngsters

- Opinions expressed to me by girls It is not essential to get married.
- I feel stifled in a typical Indian marriage
- I don't want to be the partner..... who must do all the compromising and adjusting to the husband and his family.
- I want the independence to ALSO look after my own aged parents.
- I would like my husband to come and stay in my home instead of shifting into husband's houseespecially when I am single child.

Opinions expressed to me by both girls and boys

- Marriage is an outdated institution
- I am afraid of marriage The high divorce rates is very scary and stressful and I have seen what my friends and their families are going through.
- I enjoy being single and I have big network of like-minded single friends.
- I feel live-in relationship which is far better than marriage and easier to break off. (...new laws protecting live in partner)
- I prefer a same sex relationship as it is less stressful.

Opinions expressed in my counseling session


- I don't want to add to the already rising population of our country
- I have one life want to focus on myself
- I don't want to waste 2 3 decades of my life bringing up children

 many don't take care of aging parent
 - why do we need to have children ??


Procreation is not the only aim of a woman's life

- Words like we are not a human factory are used by some and
- Words like we are not human cows used for direct breast feeding.
- There are few who feel surrogacy or adoption is a better choice than go through pregnancy and childbirth.
- Some tell me they will freeze embryos and have kids when they are more settled in their careers.
- And they only need a sperm donor don't want marriage and husband
- Happy to be single moms




How do I handle such situations?

- Use the Principals of Sexuality education.
- first teach all benefits of abstinence and monogamous relationships if that does not work out ..guide about the consequences of indulging in physical relationships too early and the emotional impact of breakups after physical intimacy and guide for safe sex .
- Since these are above 18 yrs. fortunately POCSO-12 law does not apply and I can take sexual history and advise
- Similarly, I try to give them the perspective of importance of having a stable life partner and marriage and the joys of parenthood/ motherhood.
- But ultimately we have to accept what they want and without being judgmental, still helping them with anticipatory guidance and preventive counselling is a challenge I face many times.



How do I handle such situations?

- Second step is now making parents understand and respect the decisions made by these youngsters hoping to bridge the communication gap and help to repair strained relationships and prevent it from going to the stage broken relationships.
- The results vary from case to case. This is more true for young women who are pressurized into marriage
- If I cannot persuade the girl, I convince the parents (specially for girls) that we must respect the choice each woman makes and not force the traditional role society has been imposing on her over so many decades and that has been ingrained into our societal psyche.







- Dear Adolescent Health Organization,

- And if a woman is brought up to think and behave like a man ..she will be exactly same










- I suggest you read this
- In my premarital and pre divorce counseling
- I suggest both read this book and then given them a counseling session
- In many cases I have found good results

Changing Indian Mind set of Indian parents


We have emancipated women

BUT We need to train adolescent boys to learn to deal with these emancipated women

Specially when they get married and have to learn to be equal partners and supportive husband

We need to change our gender stereotyping

- ONLY Son can only carry forward the family name
- ONLY Son will only do last rites after death
- ONLY Son would look after aging parents
- Married daughter should not be taking responsibility of her parents
- It is not right that the girls parents stay- in the home of the married daughter
- Men should not share household responsibility
- Especially affluent families where there are enough domestic servants to take the load



Respecting a woman

- How women are treated in his home and his surroundings shapes how a Adol boy will behave with a girl and in future with his wife
- If his mother or grandmother (or other women in a joint family) are disrespected, regularly castigated for small mistakes or actions by the men in the house – this is role modelling for him – this is how a woman is to be treated
- If eve teasing is accepted in the community where he is brought up- it is a way of life
- Old Hindi movies depicting the way the heroes behaved with the heroine to make her fall in love – will come under the sexual harassment act in todays world.

How to behave with girls

If a boy is a single child

If a boy has a male sibling

If a boy does not have much opportunity to mix with female cousins

If a boy has mainly male friends

HE DOES NOT KNOW HOW TO BEHAVE WITH A GIRL IN AN APPROPRIATE MANNER

As parents we need to bring up both our boys and girls to play a balanced role at home and society

Martial conflicts in Young couple

In nuclear families of today where the young couple does not have family support – it is necessary that the man becomes supportive to the wife – more so if she is working –

If this is ingrained into an adol boy —he will transition into the role of a husband very naturally and marriage will be happy and smooth

If he does it under pressure from wife or her family – not really enjoying it – it will lead to marital conflict and often leads to the path of divorce


Our girls are emancipated and empowered – but very often adol boys are not trained and have no clue how to handle this empancipated woman

Acceptance of changing sexual behavior

- Masturbation and oral sex was a sin in the past
 Today healthy expression and safe sex
- Old DSM classification Homosexuality was perversion

Today it is acceptable as different sexual orientation.


- Bonded Sex, SM –perversion.
- Today books like Fifty shades of Greytrilogy best sellers and movies



- People who practice pedophilia and incest are also claiming it to be a variation of sexuality
- It is frighteningwill this become acceptable as different sexual orientation.

Acceptance of changing sexual behaviour where will this lead us

In 2013 - When DSM-5 was released, Pedophilia was Described as 'Sexual Orientation'
In a press release, the American Psychiatric Association (APA) notes that the correct terminology is "sexual interest" and that it will correct the typo error in the manual's electronic version and in the next print edition.




"APA stands firmly behind efforts to criminally prosecute those who sexually abuse and exploit children and adolescents.

We also support continued efforts to develop treatments for those with pedophilic disorder with the goal of preventing future acts of abuse," the association added

The APA added that pedophilic disorder is a "paraphilia" and not a sexual orientation.

Other paraphilic disorders included in the manual include exhibitionistic disorder, sexual sadism disorder, and fetishistic disorder.

Normalization of Sexuality

DUTCH approach

- Differs from risk and abstinence programs
- Adolescent sexuality is a <u>normal</u> process of psychosocial and biological development
- Sexuality is a <u>continuum</u> along which youth move as maturity and relationships permit
- Adults play vital role in providing resources and supporting the development of skills

This is not the same as "permissive sexuality "

But it means "not secretive"

- An open subject is rendered negotiable
- Parents may not always be completely comfortable with teen sex, but they do not want it to lead to deception
- Sex should not lead to secrets but discussed openly between family members
- Sex should not cause conflict and alienation between parents and teenagers

 Change from "parentectomy" to parental involvement when appropriate/possible

Dutch Culture and Adolescent Sexuality: Normalization

READINESS AND SELF-REGULATION

- Teens to self regulate
- Parents stress that sexual development should occur gradually
- Concept of "virgin"
- A range of behavior, not limited to intercourse

SEX AS PREPARATION

- Preparation is part of readiness for sex
- Contraception and condom use are expected preparations for sex

FALLING IN LOVE IS COMMON

Being in love is a common experience (Including for teens)

In national survey, 63% of Dutch youth say they are "very much" in love with their current sexual partner

RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE SEXES

- Parents support relationships
 - Not casual sex
- Sex is part of a relationship
 - Reflects mutual desires and interests

Changing concepts of morality

Hymenoplasty

- In the 2010 era this was a raging debate
- Girls who believed that they had equal right to enjoy premarital sex as boys
- Marrying a boy chosen by their parents from a conservative mind set where a "woman's virginity is sacrosanct" was an issue
- Hence restoration of "virginity " was important and necessary in that situation for them
- The charge is anywhere between 1-2 lakhs ...not affordable to all

Ethical debate –

- Boys: this is gross cheating and betrayal and both the girls and doctors who
 do this should be punished.
- Girls: men who give so much importance to virginity deserve to be cheated.
- Boys: the girls should come clean and it is upto the boy whether to marry a non virgin or not. Girls can also exercise their right
- Girls: Why is society so unfair to insist on a "womans virginity" only. Men have no "test" to prove or disprove their virginity
- Doctors for : There is no moral issue involved . It is a simple surgical procedure
- Doctors against: This is not this is not a procedure I will do. Many of them said they do not perform abortions also unless really medically indicated for saving womans life

- Chinese solution to "virginity"
- Trust Chinese people to find a low -cost device for any and everything
- In a session in the IAAH conference at Turkey in 2013 in the session on Adolescent sexuality they presented a "virginity kit" that was available online
- I had taken a photo but could not locate the slide
- It consists of a membrane that can be "stuck on "

The Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, commonly known as the PoSH Act, was passed in 2013.

It defined sexual harassment, lay down the procedures for complaint and inquiry, and the action to be taken in cases of sexual harassment

- Indian families are enmeshed
- Enmeshment describes family relationships that lack boundaries such that roles and expectations are confused, parents are overly and inappropriately reliant on their children for support, and children are not allowed to become emotionally independent or separate from their parents.

What is the difference between attachment and detachment?

While these two terms are often mistaken for one another, non-attachment and detachment are in truth completely different concepts.

Non-attachment is essentially is a practice of mindfulness and presence in the existing moment.

Detachment, on the other hand, means a complete lack of interest in the world around you.
